SHIPHT DREAMS CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION SUMMIT

YOUTH INTERNSHIP AND WORK-BASED LEARNING EXPERIENCES

The SHIPHT Internship program provides work-based learning and career exploration in entrepreneurship and areas with shortages that have been identified as high-need careers. Utilizing previously obtained data, participants work with business partners to truly understand "a day in the life" in a desired area of interest. Participants also receive mentorship (with both a near- peer mentors and from experienced leaders), culturally affirming programming developed for youth by youth, soft skills and financial literacy. Additionally, we focus on ensuring our participant population closely resembles that of our nearest school district with both mentors and students. Sponsor or host an intern today!

GOALS

Our goal is to provide youth with programming that does the following:

- * Inspires diverse youth to become advocates for change in their schools and communities.
- * Empowers youth into becoming proactive in breaking gender, racial, and cultural barriers.
- * Connects diverse youth with community organizations that may aid them in achieving success.
- * Serves youth with educational and leadership opportunities that will encourage them to achieve their highest career and leadership goals.

4 Focus Areas Include:

- High Needs Career Technical Education Career Fields: We create an interactive environment where youth explore valuable career goals to include: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) to increase career trajectory and reduce rates of poverty.
- Leadership Development: Servant Leadership Principles to guide leadership
 development with activities where students are encouraged to give priority to
 the needs of those they serve while preparing the way for developing student
 leaders to follow.
- Social Innovation & Entrepreneurship: Students learn skills and techniques to solve problems while creating socially responsible companies and organizations that become engines of change in their communities.
- Financial Literacy: Basic Financial Principles, including the steps to entrepreneurship, provides a solid financial foundation for participating students.

According to McKinsey Company, the inclusion of black families in the financial system would also create new opportunities for financial services companies. Research shows that financial institutions could realize approximately \$2 billion in incremental, additional annual revenue if black Americans had the same access to financial products as white Americans. If black Americans reached full parity in terms of wealth, financial services companies could realize up to \$60 billion in additional revenue from black customers each year.

Our response is to create a learning and earning track that works with historically underrepresented youth to provide an immersive financial services internship and soft skills training.
